

NYLON RESIN

Common features of Zytel® nylon resin include mechanical and physical properties such as high mechanical strength, excellent balance of stiffness and toughness, good high temperature performance, good electrical and flammability properties, good abrasion and chemical resistance. In addition, Zytel® nylon resins are available in different modified and reinforced grades to create a wide range of products with tailored properties for specific processes and end-uses. Zytel® nylon resin, including most flame retardant grades, offer the ability to be coloured.

The good melt stability of Zytel® nylon resin normally enables the recycling of properly handled production waste. If recycling is not possible, we recommend, as the preferred option, incineration with energy recovery (-31kl/g of base polymer) in appropriately equipped installations. For disposal, local regulations have to be observed.

Zytel® nylon resin typically is used in demanding applications in the automotive, furniture, domestic appliances, sporting goods and construction industry.

Zytel® 70G13HS1L NC010 is a 13% glass fiber reinforced, heat stabilised polyamide 66 resin for injection moulding.



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Stress-strain (dry) (measured on Zytel® 70G13L NC010)



Stress-strain (cond.) (measured on Zytel® 70G13L NC010)




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Secant modulus-strain (dry) (measured on Zytel® 70G13L NC010)




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
Secant modulus-strain (cond.) (measured on Zytel® 70G13L NC010)
